Neck Pain and Disability Scale (NPAD)

Objectives: Composite index including 20 items which measure the intensity of pain; its interference with vocational, recreational, social, and functional aspects of living; and the presence and extent of associated emotional factors.

Target population: Patients with neck pain including pain related to osteoarthritis

Method of use: Patients respond to each item by marking along a 10cm visual analog scale. Items score range from 0 to 5, and the total score is a total of the item scores. Completion of the NPAD usually requires less than 5 minutes.
